### A Note from Pastor Matt

Grace and peace y'all! It's OCTOBER! How has this year flown by so quickly? There, of course, is a lot still left in the year before we close the book on 2024, but it definitely has felt like we have moved through it so quickly.

As I look forward to all of what October and the fall(ish) season brings to us at Redeemer and Newberry ('cooler' weather, football, and pumpkins), I wanted to lift up a new ministry that we are hopeful to be successful at Redeemer and in the Newberry Community.

Historically, the church has struggled to engage adults between the ages of 18 and 45 effectively. These "young" and "young-ish" adults often face transitions—college, careers, relationships, and personal growth—yet the church hasn't always walked with them on these journeys. Too often, this age group slips away, feeling disconnected from faith communities that don't seem to address their unique needs.

We're introducing YAWAY—"Young Adults Walking Alongside YHWH"—as part of our commitment to changing that. YAWAY isn't just a catchy name. It's a call to meet young adults where they are, understanding that they're already on a spiritual journey. What many are searching for isn't a traditional model of church participation but a space where they can ask hard questions, explore their faith, and connect meaningfully with others. Of course, there is also the need and desire to have fun while exploring those deep journeys. So, this group will also have plenty of 'fun'!

At its heart, YAWAY invites us to rethink ministry. How can we support young adults through life's challenges? How can we create spaces for them to engage faith in real and relevant ways? This is about more than new programs—it's about re-envisioning how we welcome, listen, and walk alongside the next generation.

As an ELCA congregation, we are rooted in grace and hope. Our future and present depend on embracing all generations, including young adults, as essential members of our community. Together, let's ensure that YAWAY becomes not just a ministry but a reflection of our commitment to love and inclusion.

So, join us as we walk together in this journey of faith at Madmax Taphouse on October 3rd beginning at 7 pm!






